## Entries will be limited and will close on 24th January 2016

The Tukituki River is closed from 5pm on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> January from it's confluence with the Tukipo River downstream to the Tapairu Rd. Reserve (ie. where that road meets the river). There is no designated back up venue in the case of adverse weather. During the competition, all anglers can have an additional rigged rod set up on the bank (for this competition). Competitors please take note in order for their card to score it needs to have on it their licence number as this is a requirement of the Hawkes Bay Fish and Game Council (exceptions at discretion of the organisers). Safety information will be e mailed out to entrants and be part of the event briefing. One conventional fly rod, not more than twelve feet/three hundred and sixty-six centimeters in length, may be used at one time. Competitors may have spare fly rods with them (carried on their body or bank side assembled), as long as only one line is in the water. Competitors are responsible for carrying and protecting their own equipment during the competition sessions.

Meeting venue, car park outside Dave Hern's Fishing & Shooting Outfitters, corner of Ruataniwha Street and Railway Esplanade, Waipukurau.

Cheap accommodation is available at the Waipukurau Holiday Park and River's Edge Holiday Park, Waipawa. Please contact them direct.

Controllers must be able and comfortable with crossing the river. Anglers will be required to cross the river with the controller whenever the controller needs to cross.
