The Waimakariri & Waihou will be \underline{closed} from the 7^{th} of December 2015, as follows: Waihou – immediately above the Whites Road Bridge down, to 500m below the confluence with the Waimakariri Steam

Waimakariri – Upstream along Waimakariri Road down to the confluence with the Waihou).

Please note that with the current summer weather patterns we have elected to reserve both these venues for the competition, one of which will be a back-up venue.

ALL ANGLERS must follow CHECK CLEAN & DRY principles to prevent the spread of Didymo and other aquatic pests.

By entering this event, the entrant warrants that they are fit for the competition. Neither Sport Fly Fishing NZ Inc nor the organizer will be held responsible for any loss or injury that may arise from this competition. The entrant also agrees that should they win the competition they will furnish a report, on their tactics and techniques, and supply to the organizer for distribution to all competitors and controllers, within 10days of the event.

During the competition, all anglers can have an additional rigged rod set up on the bank (for this competition). <u>However</u>, while the additional rod can have the line treaded and reel attached, it must be broken down or apart in at least one section of the rod to comply with Auckland Waikato Fish&Game. In switching rods anglers will be required to comply with these requirements for the additional rod which is not being fished with.
