Smoking and Vaping Policy

Introduction

1. The purpose of this document is to outline SFFNZ's policy with regards to smoking and vaping during competitions.

Smoking

- 2. Smoking cigarettes is prohibited on board all boats during SFFNZ competitions. This is both due to the associated harm caused by second-hand smoke to the non-smoking angler, as well as the potential dangers with smoking on a small boat in proximity to fuel tanks.
- 3. Smoking during river competitions is permitted, with the following exceptions:
 - a. If it is in proximity to a non-smoking angler, or controller (smokers should move away from non-smokers), and
 - b. If smoking is prohibited within the venue that SFFNZ is holding the competition. For example the owners of Mohaka Farm have made their entire property a non-smoking venue. Smoking on beats that run through this property is therefore prohibited.
 - c. If SFFNZ deems that the environmental risk posed by smoking in the area of the competition merits the competition to be a non-smoking event (for example due to dry conditions, or a high fire risk).
- 4. In all circumstances, smokers are to ensure they dispose of butts in a responsible manner, especially with regards to potential fire risks at venues in dry conditions.

Vaping

5. The use of e-cigarettes (vaping) is permitted on board boats only if both parties consent. Should either angler declare that they do not want e-cigarettes used on the boat, then this decision is to be respected, without exception.
